Registration Fee and Refund Policy:

A **\$100.00 non-refundable** deposit must accompany your child's registration. Balance of fee is due no later than 2 weeks prior to camp. Make check or money order payable to Kimball Camp YMCA and mail to: 4444 Long Lake Rd., Reading, MI 49274. Kimball Camp YMCA also accepts Master Card, Visa, and Discover. If the fees are not received 2 weeks prior to camp, the camp reserves the right to fill that space with a camper on the waiting list. Candy credits are applied to camp fees with any additional amount issued to a camp store account. Candy credits are non-refundable, non-transferable, and must be used for the 2011 Summer Camp season.

Transportation from Quincy/Coldwater and Hillsdale is available at a charge of \$35.00 per week. Extended hours are also available. Please call for more information.


Letter from the Executive Director

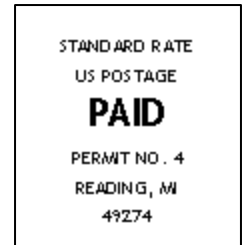
